

What To Bring

- **Identification:** At the time of admission, please bring a copy of your Medicare, Social Security, and Supplemental Insurance Cards.
- **Insurance:** Renters insurance is encouraged to cover the cost of household goods and personal property. General liability coverage is also encouraged.
- **Furniture:** Apartments at the Gardens are NOT furnished. Residents are required to bring any furnishings they wish to make their apartment their home.
- **Bedding and linens:** All bedding and linens will be provided by the resident.
- **Toiletries:** Toiletries such as shampoo, toothpaste, soap, etc. are the responsibility of the resident.
- **Personal entertainment:** Residents are encouraged to bring reading material, movies, games and other items for personal enjoyment that they would normally have in their home.
- **Clothing:** All clothing will be provided by the resident. It is recommended that clothing is marked with the residents name if staff will be assisting with laundry.
- **Phone:** If a resident wishes to have a landline phone, they are responsible for making those arrangements. The same goes for cellular devices.
- **Television:** While satellite television is available, residents are responsible for providing the TV itself.
- **List of important phone numbers:** It is necessary for residents to have a way to contact the important people in their lives. A list of important phone numbers kept in a safe place helps insure that.
